CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under the supervision of the Striping Crew Supervisor, this position is responsible for driving a tractor/trailer loaded with paint to all parts of the state as part of the striping crew.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Load and operate tractor/trailer hauling barrels of paint and beads to all parts of the state.
- Perform preventive maintenance servicing of assigned vehicle.
- Work as member of striping crew.
- Perform cleanup duties.
- Assist sign crews and work in sign shop or District occasionally.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

The educational equivalent to a high school diploma. Ability to load and unload bags of glass beads and physically maneuver paint drums. Ability and experience to safely operator tractor/trailer equipment. Constant statewide travel. Ability to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, and to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records. Valid Class A commercial driver's license with tanker ("N") endorsement. Pre-employment drug test required and subject to additional drug/alcohol testing according to the provisions of the AHTD Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.
