## CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under the supervision of the Sealing Job Superintendent, this position is responsible for operating a tractor-trailer tank truck in hauling hot liquid asphalt and other materials to construction/maintenance job sites.

## EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Operate tractor-trailer truck hauling hot liquid asphalt, prime oil, and other materials to job site.
- Move equipment from one job site to another.
- Perform preventive maintenance and service assigned equipment.
- Operate other equipment as needed.
- Load, unload and stack bags of salt, sand, cement, chemicals, etc.

## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Ability to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, and to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records. Ability to operate a tractor-trailer truck at full proficiency. Ability to perform preventive maintenance of assigned vehicle. Good eyesight and depth perception. Valid Class A commercial driver's license with tanker ("N") endorsement. Pre-employment drug test required and subject to additional drug/alcohol testing according to the provisions of the AHTD Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.
