CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under general supervision, this position is responsible for operating and maintaining the heating and cooling boiler machinery located in the physical plant for the Central Headquarters complex.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Keep constant check by observing and reading gauges hourly to assure the boilers are operating correctly.
- Sweep, mop and dust boiler room.
- Perform minor repair on machinery.
- Maintain cooling towers.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

The educational equivalent to a diploma from an accredited high school. State Boiler Operator's license. Ability to read necessary gauges and mechanical knowledge of machinery. Valid driver's license

("Accredited" means the educational institution or program is accredited by an accrediting organization recognized either by the United States Department of Education or by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.)
