### CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under the direction of the Job Superintendent, this position is responsible for operating, at full performance, a mobile crane used in transferring construction materials or in clearing rights of way and constructing roadways for construction/maintenance jobs.

### EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Drive crane to job site and maneuver it into a safe and efficient working position.
- Transport concrete from trucks to forms.
- Operate dragline and clam shell bucket used to transport and excavate materials or clean drainage ditches and stream channels.
- Perform preventive maintenance and safety checks on assigned vehicle.
- Perform other maintenance activities as needed.

### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Ability to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, and to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records. Full proficiency in the operation of a rubber tired, mobile cable crane and/or track mounted crane. Knowledge of crane capacities and repair as well as emergency operating procedures. Valid Class A commercial driver's license with tanker ("N") endorsement. Pre-employment drug test required and subject to additional drug/alcohol testing according to the provisions of the AHTD Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.
