CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under general supervision, this position is responsible for the operation and maintenance of pumps used to spray hot asphalt on the surface of roads and shoulders to adequately secure stone chip and seal cracked surfaces.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Operate asphalt spraying apparatus daily.
- Perform other maintenance duties when required.
- Occasionally operate a front end loader, roller and dump truck.
- Adjust and maintain the distributor routinely.
- Load, unload and stack bags of salt, sand, cement, chemicals, etc.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Ability to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, and to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records. Knowledge in the operation of an asphalt spraying apparatus. Valid Class A commercial driver's license with tanker ("N") endorsement. Pre-employment drug test required and subject to additional drug/alcohol testing according to the provisions of the AHTD Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.
