CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

This position is responsible for performing complex engineering work in specialized fields of highway engineering, such as highway construction, design, materials testing, hydraulics, etc.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Supervise survey parties.
- Review construction plans.
- Direct and review highway material tests for compliance with plans and specifications.
- Direct the compiling, analyzing, and recording of data concerning locations, mileages, physical characteristics, types, and usages of highways.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Possession of a current *Arkansas* license to practice professional engineering or graduation from an EAC of ABET approved engineering curriculum or equivalent as judged by the Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors. Engineer Intern certification required. Experience in area of work performed.

("EAC of ABET" means Engineering Accreditation Commission of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology.)
