**CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK**

Under immediate supervision, this position is responsible for assisting in various engineering related tasks as required.

**EXAMPLES OF WORK**

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Participate in orientation sessions within each engineering area of the Department.
- Receive specialized training from designated training personnel.
- Perform a wide variety of engineering tasks in a learning capacity.
- Inspect materials and work performed by highway construction contractors on-site.
- Maintain records to ensure proper construction and accurate quantities.

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

Possession of a current *Arkansas* license to practice professional engineering or graduation from an EAC of ABET approved engineering curriculum or equivalent as judged by the Arkansas Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors. Valid driver's license when working in the Construction or Maintenance divisions.

("EAC of ABET" means Engineering Accreditation Commission of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology.)
