*CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK*

Under direction of the Staff Research Engineer, this position is responsible for data collection for the Research Section.

*EXAMPLES OF WORK*

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. - Coordinate and conduct field work for Research Section activities.
- Serve as a Study Coordinator for research projects.
- Maintain working knowledge of Intelligent Transportation System architectural recommendations for statewide and regional application.
- Serve as Department liaison in coordination requirements with other state and federal agencies.
- Conduct a literature review and prepare state-of-the-art report on any research subject.

*MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS*

The educational equivalent to a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. Experience in Microsoft Word and Excel and a basic understanding of computer networking. Valid driver's license. Constant statewide travel.
