CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under general supervision, this position is responsible for the operation, care, and maintenance of a motor patrol to support District construction and maintenance operations.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Perform duties for construction and maintenance operations requiring cutting ditches and grades and spreading various road building materials.
- Perform regular servicing and preventive maintenance on assigned equipment.
- Perform field maintenance, minor repairs, etc.
- Operate other types of equipment as required.
- Load, unload and stack bags of salt, sand, cement, chemicals, etc.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Ability to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, and to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records. Ability to visualize grades and thorough familiarity with the operation, capabilities, and limitations of the equipment. Valid Class A commercial driver's license with tanker ("N") endorsement. Pre-employment drug test required and subject to additional drug/alcohol testing according to the provisions of the AHTD Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.
