CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under general supervision, this position is responsible for field pavement profile data collection and analysis.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Collect pavement profile data utilizing light weight profilometers or best available technology.
- Assist Research Study Coordinators with compiling and analyzing pavement profile data.
- Review and prepare pavement profile data for reports to Department personnel.
- Conduct a literature review to maintain state-of-the-art technology on pavement profile data collection.
- Perform routine calibration and maintenance of pavement profile equipment.
- Answer inquiries from Department and other sources.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

The educational equivalent to a diploma from an accredited high school. Ability to read maps, write legibly and operate computerized equipment. Available to work a flexible schedule. Working knowledge of Microsoft Word and Excel desired. Valid driver's license.

("Accredited" means the educational institution or program is accredited by an accrediting organization recognized either by the United States Department of Education or by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.)
