CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under the supervision of the Shop Supervisor, this position is responsible for performing, at full performance, maintenance, repair, and safety inspection of the District's vehicles.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Perform complicated and extensive repairs to specialized equipment and systems.
- Perform annual preventive maintenance inspections.
- Test vehicles after repair.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Thorough demonstrated knowledge of automotive mechanics and principles. Ability to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, and to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records. Valid Class A commercial driver's license with tanker ("N") endorsement. Pre-employment drug test required and subject to additional drug/alcohol testing according to the provisions of the AHTD Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.
