CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under the supervision of the Sign Crew Supervisor, this position is responsible for erecting traffic control signs.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Operate jackhammer while driving sign support post.
- Work approximately 12 to 15 feet above the ground from a platform attached to a supply truck.
- Attach signs to the post.
- Flag traffic.
- Load, unload and stack bags of salt, sand, cement, chemicals, etc.
- Perform cleanup duties.

APPLICABLE TO THE MAINTENANCE DIVISION:

- Assist pavement marking crews and work in sign shop or District occasionally.
- Perform preventative maintenance of assigned vehicle.
- Perform cleanup duties.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Ability to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, and to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records. Constant statewide travel required in the Maintenance Division. Valid Class A commercial driver's license with tanker ("N") endorsement. Pre-employment drug test required and subject to additional drug/alcohol testing according to the provisions of the AHTD Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.
