CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under the supervision of the Striping Supervisor, this position is responsible for the performance of a striping crew.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Operate controls on the equipment that dispenses paint and reflective beads on the highways.
- Supervise four-man striping crew.
- Repair, maintain, and understand highly complicated electrical and plumbing equipment that dispenses both paint and reflective beads.
- Keep daily time, equipment, and material reports.
- Occasionally assist sign erection crews and work in sign shop or District.
- Perform cleanup duties.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

The educational equivalent to a diploma from an accredited high school. Ability and experience to supervise striping crew operations. Ability, knowledge, and experience to repair, maintain, and understand complex mechanics of striping machines. Ability to perform all phases of striping operation including driving striper, and thorough familiarity with all highway routes. Must be able to keep accurate documentation of daily time, equipment, material, and other reports as required. Constant statewide travel. Ability to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, and to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records. Valid Class A commercial driver's license with tanker ("N") endorsement. Pre-employment drug test required and subject to additional drug/alcohol testing according to the provisions of the AHTD Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.

("Accredited" means the educational institution or program is accredited by an accrediting organization recognized either by the United States Department of Education or by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.)
