CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK

Under the supervision of the Striping Crew Supervisor, this position is responsible for driving a heavy truck while dispensing paint on the highway.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Assume duties and responsibilities of Striping Crew Supervisor when needed.
- Drive heavy multi-axle truck both straight and tapered while loaded with paint and beads.
- Read codes placed on highway by striping zoners so that no-passing zones begin and end in proper travel lanes.
- Perform preventive maintenance of assigned vehicle.
- Occasionally assist sign erection crews and work in sign shop or District.
- Perform cleanup duties.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

The educational equivalent to a diploma from an accredited high school. Thorough familiarity with all state highway routes. Ability to recognize and interpret zoning procedures. Ability to understand and implement sketches shown on channelization plans. Ability, knowledge, and experience to safely operate striping machine equipment. Ability to assume duties and responsibilities of Striping Crew Supervisor when needed. Constant statewide travel. Ability to read and speak the English language sufficiently to converse with the general public, to understand highway traffic signs and signals in the English language, and to respond to official inquiries, and to make entries on reports and records. Valid Class A commercial driver's license with tanker ("N") endorsement. Pre-employment drug test required and subject to additional drug/alcohol testing according to the provisions of the AHTD Drug and Alcohol Testing Program.

("Accredited" means the educational institution or program is accredited by an accrediting organization recognized either by the United States Department of Education or by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.)
