*CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK*

This position is accountable for the conduct of traffic operation studies, for development of traffic signalization, signing, work zone traffic control and channelization plans, and for providing assistance to city officials in traffic operation matters.

*EXAMPLES OF WORK*

The following examples are intended only as illustrations of various types of work performed. No attempt is made to be exhaustive. Related, similar, or other logical duties are performed as assigned. The Department may require employees to perform functions beyond those contained in job descriptions. The Department may modify job descriptions based on Department needs. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department is an "at will" employer.

- Lay out complicated striping, channelization, work zone traffic control, and signing projects.
- Review critical access driveway permits and make recommendations concerning permits.
- Conduct various traffic studies.
- Observe on-site conditions and analyze data.

*MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS*

The educational equivalent to a diploma from an accredited high school. Advanced training in subprofessional engineering work or experience in traffic engineering. Experience in the design of highway signs and in the preparation of plans and specifications for highway signing projects. Ability to work with citizens and public officials on highway related matters.

*("Accredited" means the educational institution or program is accredited by an accrediting organization recognized either by the United States Department of Education or by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation.)*
