Please submit:

- Completed Annual Renewal application.
- Annual Permit renewal fee of \$50 in the form of a check or money order made payable to the **Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department**. (No other form of payment is acceptable.)
- Copy of the applicant's Certificate of Insurance showing limits of coverage (\$1 million minimum is required).
- The *company's* latest financial *information (balance sheet and income statement)*.
- Current list of equipment to be used along with annual inspection or roadside inspection.*

A written statement showing any changes that have been made in (please check as appropriate):

- Ownership of the company.
- The applicant's training and safety programs.
- No change.

Copies of changes must be submitted with application.

General Information and Instructions for Hazardous Waste Transportation Permit Renewal

- I. All transporters of hazardous wastes must obtain a permit from the Arkansas Highway Police Permit Section prior to transporting a hazardous waste in the State of Arkansas. Questions concerning the application process should be directed to the Arkansas Highway Police at (501) 569-2546.

- II. *In lieu of copies of each annual inspection, a statement that the annual inspections and/or roadside inspections are currently on file at:*

and will be available for review if needed, may be submitted if the list of equipment is more than twenty (20) vehicles.

- III. *The list of equipment should include Make, Model, Year, VIN Number, and Current Value.*

- IV. The physical address of the Arkansas Highway Police is 10324 Interstate 30, Little Rock, Arkansas 72209. The mailing address is P.O. Box 2779, Little Rock, AR 72203-2779.

- V. For hire common and contract carriers planning to transport any hazardous waste having commercial value, must have intrastate operating authority issued by the Arkansas State Highway Commission before applying for a Hazardous Waste Transportation Permit. Application for this authority may be made by contacting the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department’s Legal Division at 569-2355.

- VI. Private carriers, as defined by the Arkansas Motor Carrier Act, are not required to obtain operating authority, regardless of whether or not the waste has value.

- VII. The applicant’s U.S. DOT Safestat Rating will be reviewed in processing the renewal application. Those carriers having a rating of “satisfactory” will be issued a permit. Those with a rating of “unsatisfactory” will be denied a permit. Carriers without a safety rating or with a rating of “conditional” will be issued a conditional permit.

- VIII. Hazardous Waste Transportation Permits are nontransferable and are valid for one year from the date of original issue.

- IX. Hazardous Waste Transportation Permits may be suspended or revoked in whole, or in part, as provided in Section 14 of the Arkansas Motor Carrier Act, for cause, including but not limited to the following:
 - a. Violation of any terms of the permit or the Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act;
 - b. Any violation of the rules and regulations adopted by the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department pursuant to the Arkansas Motor Carrier Act, the Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act, or the Arkansas Hazardous Material Transportation Act;
 - c. Any violation of applicable rules and regulations adopted by the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality; or
 - d. Misrepresentation of any material fact in the permit application.

REMINDER: The Arkansas Highway Police does not automatically issue renewal notices. It is the responsibility of each permit holder to make application for renewal each year.
