

## IFTA FAQ's

### 1. Do I need an IFTA License?

An interstate motor carrier operating “qualified motor vehicles” between member jurisdictions\* must have an International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) license and decals issued by their base jurisdiction. The license and decals must be renewed annually and quarterly reports must be filed to maintain valid IFTA credentials.

\* Member Jurisdictions – The 48 contiguous states of the United States and the 10 Canadian provinces

### 2. What is a qualified motor vehicle?

IFTA defines a “qualified motor vehicle” as a motor vehicle used, designed, or maintained for transportation of persons or property and :

- Having two axles and a gross vehicle weight or registered gross vehicle weight exceeding 26,000 pounds or 11,797 kilograms; or
- Having three or more axles regardless of weight; or
- Is used in combination, when the weight of such combination exceeds 26,000 pounds or 11,797 kilograms gross vehicle or registered gross vehicle weight. Qualified motor vehicle does not include recreational vehicles.

*Farm or Natural Resource plated vehicles and school buses*
