Interstate 55 Bridge Inspection Will Require Lane Closure In Crittenden County

CRITTENDEN COUNTY (12-1) – Crews conducting a routine inspection of the Interstate 55 Bridge over the Mississippi River between West Memphis and Memphis will require lane closures the next two weeks, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) officials.

Beginning **Monday, December 4** and continuing through **Wednesday, December 6**, the northbound, outside lane will be closed between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. On **Wednesday, December 6** and continuing through **Tuesday, December 12**, the southbound, outside lane will be closed between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.

No lane closures are scheduled on Fridays, Saturdays or Sundays.
